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After multiple mini-remodels and more than 20 years of living in this home, Interior Designer Jill Pfeiffer and her husband—soon-to-be-empty nesters—finally committed to redesigning their entire home to create a cohesive, functional layout that reflects their tastes and lifestyle. "I designed this space to be about warmth with an eye toward art and lighting," Pfeiffer says. She loves clean lines, natural materials and classic elements; these signatures are cohesive throughout the home.

An open floor plan with a kitchen island, ample pantry space and a connection to the outdoors was top billing for the design. To create a warm, inviting ambiance, Pfeiffer selected a variety of natural materials in rich colors with interesting textures. 
